INSTRUCTIONS

It is very important that you have a thorough understanding of the program you are applying for. Please see the main website at www.bunac.org and check the specific *Work in France* information and eligibility. We really want to be sure that you know what each program is (and is not) so you can make an informed choice. You can request a brochure online or obtain a copy from your campus Careers/Study Abroad office.

FLIGHTS

With BUNAC, you always have the choice to book your travel through any agent you wish. Please balance price against flexibility, especially the ability to change the return date and/or routing (most participants do one or the other or both). Make sure that the airline/agent has a local office in your destination country.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply, please submit all of the following to BUNAC in Connecticut:

- Completed *Work in France* application. Be sure to read eligibility requirements and sign the declaration at the bottom of section one of the application.
- Proof of full-time student status (section 2 of the application or your official transcript).
- Completed reference (section 3 of the application) or a separate letter of recommendation from an instructor or employer who has known you for at least six months.
- Completed French test.
- Proof of funds equivalent to €1,500 (this should be a copy of your most recent bank statement).
- Completed BUNAC Insurance Declaration Form and applicable premium (BUNAC insurance is mandatory).
- Program fee of \$695. This should be either a money order or cashier's check made payable to BUNAC USA. Unfortunately, we cannot accept personal checks.

PROGRAM CANCELLATION CONDITIONS

When you sign the application form, you are agreeing to the published program conditions including cancellations terms. For ease of reference, these are summarized below – please read them carefully.

If you have any questions at all, please call us toll-free during regular office hours (East Coast time) at 1-800-GO-BUNAC.

N.B. In all cases, a cancellation must be received in writing and is only effective from the date we receive it. Remember also that separate cancellation fees and conditions will undoubtedly apply to any flight bookings you make.
